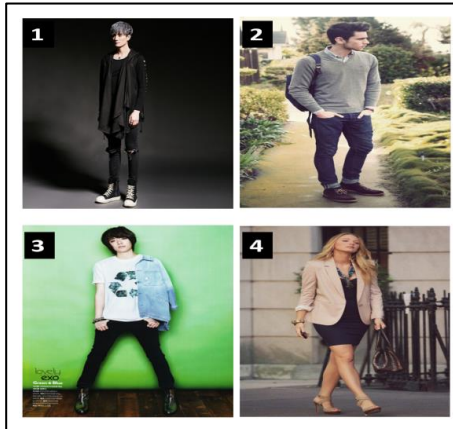

scruffy	clothes that look untidy or old/in bad condition
