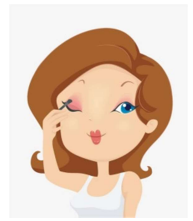

Synonyms of Beautiful

- 1) **Stunning** – extremely impressive or attractive
- 2) **Attractive** – pleasant to look at
- 3) **Lovely** – attractive or beautiful especially in a graceful or elegant way.
- 4) **Gorgeous** – very attractive or beautiful (physical attraction)
- 5) **Pretty** – attractive in a delicate or more innocent way
- 6) **Exquisite** – beautiful in a very delicate way.
- 7) **Sightly** – pleasing or satisfying to the eye
- 8) **Good-looking** – (mainly of a person) attractive
- 9) **Adorable** – charming and cute (but a bit stronger than 'cute')
- 10) **Wonderful** – beautiful that gives the feeling of admiration or delight

1. As pretty as a picture	Very attractive or appealing in appearance	The young bride looked as pretty as a picture in her dress.
2. Go under the knife	To have/undergo surgery	She looked so different before she went under the knife .
3. Beauty is only skin-deep	Physical beauty is not as important as someone's personality.	It's more important to be kind than to be beautiful. Beauty is only skin-deep , after all.
4. Look like a million dollars	To look extremely good or attractive	He wore a suit that made him look like a million dollars .
5. Drop-dead gorgeous	Very good looking or attractive	The fans screamed as they saw the drop-dead gorgeous singer on stage.
