- 1) **Affectionate** – very loving

- 4) **bad-tempered** – gets angry a lot
- 5) **charismatic** – attracts other people; good at getting people's attention
- 6) **extroverted** – very outgoing
- 7) **egotistical** – (negative) acts as if they are more important than others
- 8) **gregarious** – very sociable
- 9) **introverted** – quiet and shy
- 10) **sympathetic** – understands and cares about other people's problems

1. <b>Down-to earth</b>	Someone who is humble, realistic and practical	The employees like their boss because he's <b>down-to-earth</b> and honest with them.
2. <b>Bad egg</b>	Dishonest or ill-behaved person	I don't want my son to be friends with Thomas. He's a <b>bad egg</b> .
3. <b>Nice as pie</b>	Surprisingly very kind and friendly	June may seem bad-tempered, but actually he is <b>nice as pie</b> — he's helped me carry my groceries many times.
4. <b>Live wire</b>	Someone who is very energetic and outgoing	Jake is a wonderful young boy, a real <b>live wire</b> and full of fun.
5. <b>Eager beaver</b>	An enthusiastic person who works very hard. (sometimes too much)	Bill is a real <b>eager beaver</b> , always volunteering to stay late.
