Expressions

1. bundle of nerves	Very nervous, tense, or worried	I was a bundle of nerves before the driving test started.
2. afraid of one's own shadow	Easily or always scared or frightened	After Tom was robbed, he was even afraid of his own shadow .
3. scared stiff	So scared that one cannot move	I was scared stiff when the hue dog barked at me.
4. whistle in the dark	Pretend to be not afraid	Hugh was trying to whistle in the dark , but we could see his knees shaking.
5. nerves of steel	The ability to control one's fear and remain calm even in difficult or dangerous situations.	You need nerves of steel to be a Formula One driver.
