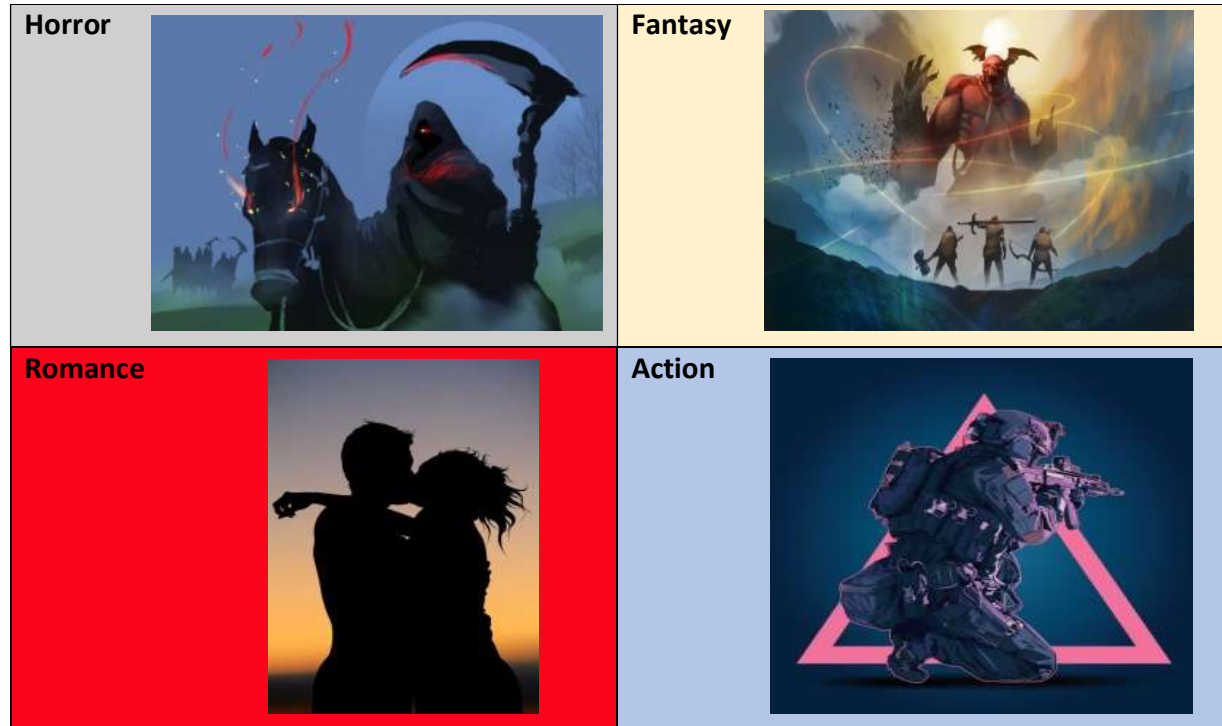

Carol: Sure. That sounds nice. I should be home by 7pm.
Ward: OK, I'll ***pick you up*** at 7pm. We can go to a restaurant near the theatre.
Carol: ***Sounds wonderful.*** I'll see you on Saturday.

<p><u><i>Sounds wonderful.</i></u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I can't wait. - Really looking forward to it. - This is going to be great.

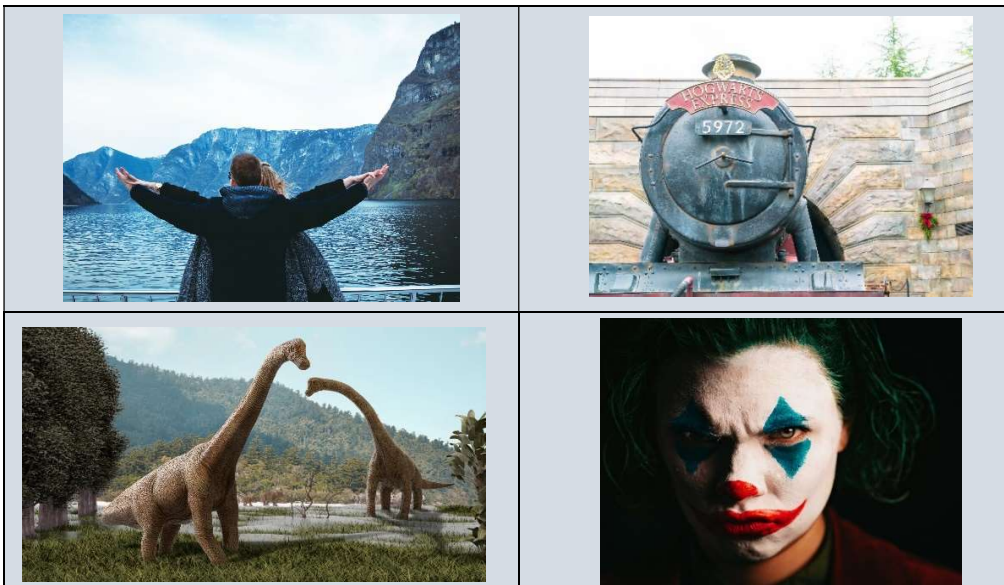
