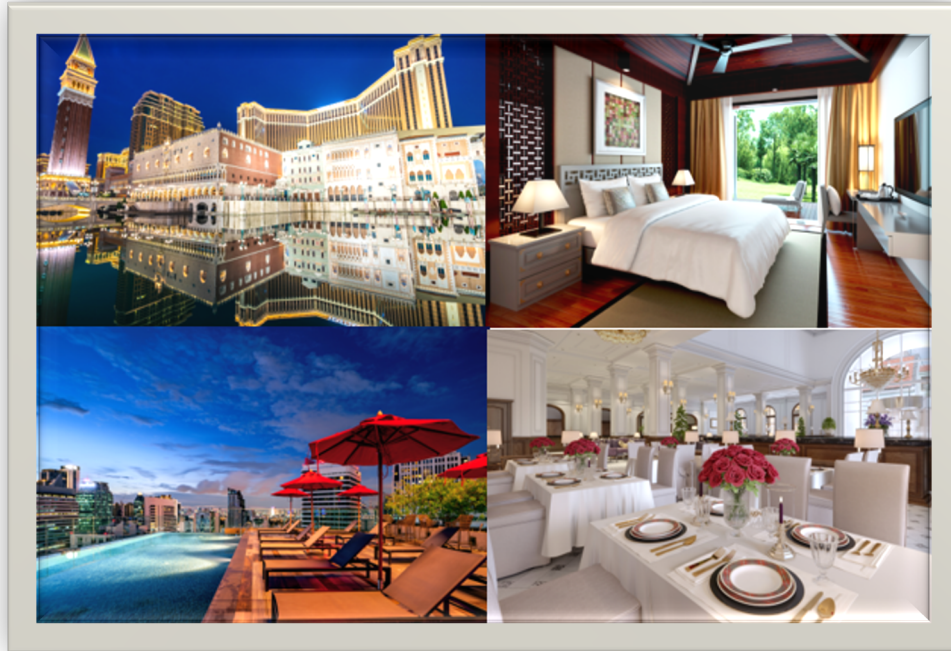


Part 1

Ken: Actually, that sounds fun, almost like a challenging game! I likely will have to move around a lot but that's okay.

Chris: As a last resort, I have a friend who has an extra bedroom, maybe you can crash there for a few days. Want me to ask him?

Ken: Sure, that would rock, as long as it's no trouble for him. Thanks so much. I was starting to feel sad about my trip but now I'm psyched again!

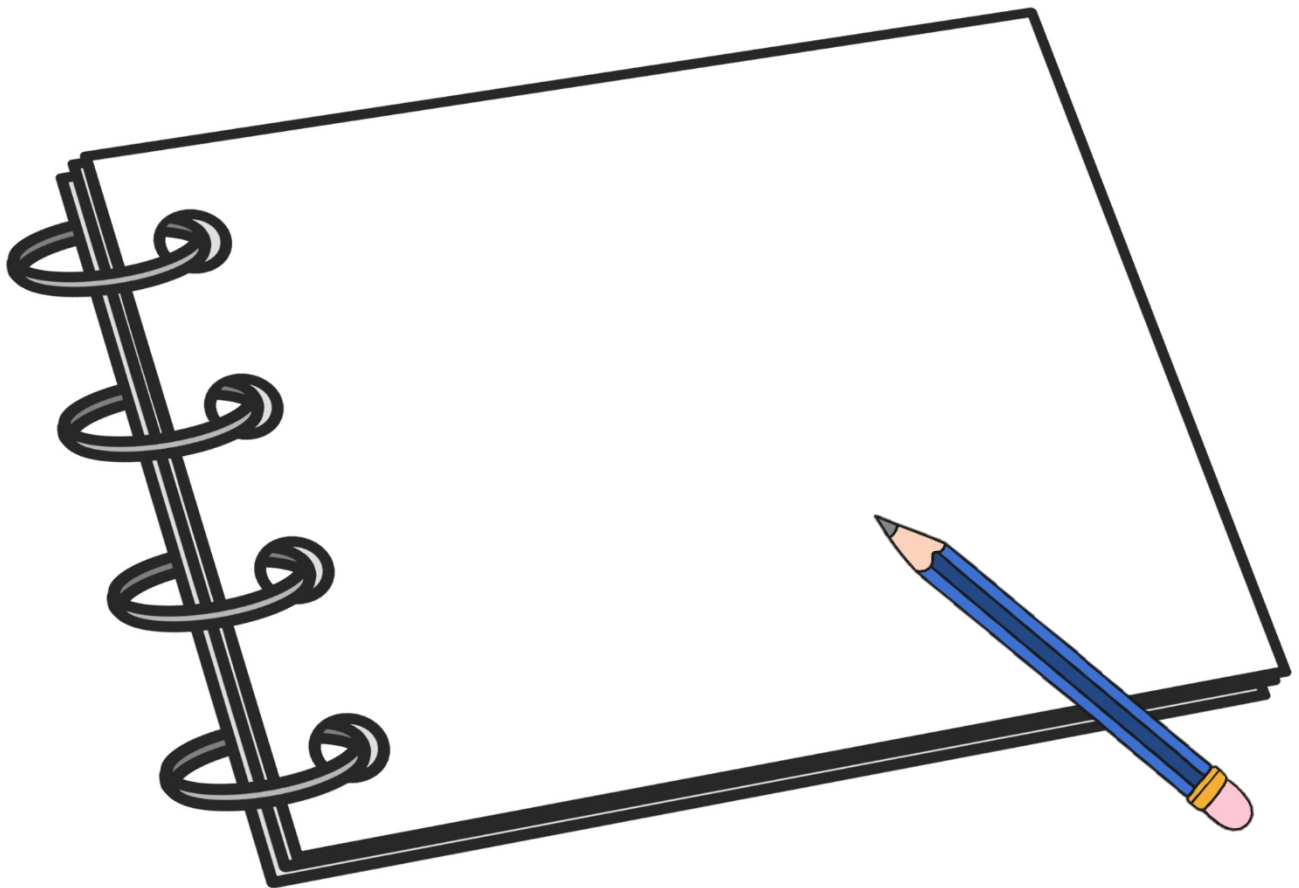
