I. INTRODUCTION

Powerball, an American lottery, has drawn the attention of many because of its **tempting jackpot**. In the hope of becoming **instant millionaires**, people buy a Powerball ticket and choose **6 possible winning numbers**. Lucky winners can choose whether to claim the money in **installments** or in a **lump sum payment**.

Claudia: What are you talking about? The odds are the same no matter what. You asked

me to pick, so I picked!

Ross: Yes, but I thought you would take it seriously.

Claudia: (exasperated) Who says I'm not taking it seriously? Numbers are numbers! Can

you go stand outside now please?

Ross: Why?

Claudia: Maybe I'll get lucky and you'll be struck by lightning!
